

## M,G & C Basics

## Rules

- o 45 minutes, 75 questions
- o Can write on test, answers must be in blanks
- o Can use blank paper

## Scoring

- Correct answer = +3 points

## M,G & C Strategies

- Maps, Graphs & Charts Questions
  - o Check the title, Look at the key, Scan the page
  - READ the question carefully
  - o <u>Estimate when possible</u> draw lines, use visual clues, etc.
- Atlas Questions
  - Learn the Atlas first!
  - Use tabs efficiently and effectively
    - Don't overtab!
    - Have students tab their own?

# M,G & C Strategies

- Work order options
  - o Maps, Graphs & Charts, then Atlas
  - o Atlas, then Maps, Graphs & Charts
  - Number order
- Practice, Practice!
  - Start with smaller sections and work your way up to a whole test
