

Changes to the 2016-17 UIL Calculator Applications Contest

There are three changes to the UIL Calculator Applications Contest effective this current 2016-17 contest year.

Calculator Clearing. Clearing of calculators will no longer be required. Calculators will not be checked or verified respecting any information stored on them prior to the start of the contest.

Page 7 Problem Order. The stated and geometry problems, #66-70, will be moved *en masse* to the top of Page 7. The numerical problems, #61-65, will be moved to the bottom of the page. For this year's tests, Problems #61-63 are stated problems, #64 and #65 are geometry problems and #66-70 are "number crunchers".

Problem #61 – Difficult stated problem in the spirit of Problems #36-38.

Problem #62 – Logarithmic solution (dealing with large and small answers)

Problem #63 – Trajectory problem.

Problems #64 and 65 – Difficult geometry problems in the spirit of Problem #60.

Study List of Repeat Problems. There is no study list for the 2016-17 contest year, and no problems will be repeated from tests of previous years.
