Things You Should Know From:

The contest will take place Friday, May 3, 2:15 PM in San Jac Multipurpose Room (SJH 207). The room will open for set up at 2 PM. Awards will be on Friday, May 3 at 8:30 PM in UTC 2.102A.

Computers: Contestants may use a laptop or notebook computer but must bring their own compact printer, paper and software. Power outlets will be available in the contest room, but contestants should bring an extension cord.

Typed entries must be double-spaced, using any standard 12-point font and 1-inch margins on $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 11$ -inch computer paper. When printing, the print command must be started by the time contest time expires.

Contestants who opt to compose their entries on computers accept the risk of computer malfunction. In case of computer malfunction, the contestant may use the remaining allotted time to complete the composition in handwriting or compose on another computer (if available).

The UIL will provide paper for contestants who wish to compose on paper. Contestants should provide their own pens. *Compositions may not be written in pencil. Written entries must be written in ink on one side of the page only.*
