- a.) When you advance from district, bi-district, area or region, changes may be made to your advancing entry via the UIL Website. **No forms are necessary.**
- b.) A red button labeled "Make Changes" will appear on the Theatre homepage during week one of zone and district competition.
- c.) The system will open for a 36-hour period on Sunday at noon and close Monday at midnight following each contest week.

You will be able to make changes if, and only if, results have been certified.

Rehearsal Information:

Rehearsals are 50 minutes in length the morning of the contest. However, 5 minutes are added to the beginning of your rehearsal for instructions and clarifications, and another 5 minutes will be added to the end of your rehearsal for scenic disclosures that may have not yet been covered, as well as allowing the contest manager to see the very start and end of your show (if not already seen). Schools should plan on unloading 45 minutes prior to their rehearsal. The official dressing room will also be made available at this time. All dressing rooms should be cleared and cleaned PRIOR to the awards ceremony.

3pm Director's Meeting in AHS library.

4pm Shows Begin and run Back-to-Back. The above times are *approximate*. The Awards Ceremony will be held as soon as the judge reaches a decision and dressing rooms are cleared.

Tickets for the contest will be \$10. Only those listed on the official eligibility form will receive a complimentary ticket.

One-Act Play Director's Checklist:

Bring this with you and have it ready PRIOR to your Official Rehearsal:

- o Check for Region Entry Fee (made out to Atascocita High School Theatre Arts) *see below
- o Original Eligibility Form completed online and any changes made before the deadline
- o A separate script with cuts marked (no photocopies)
- o UIL documentation for additions to the basic set
- o Documentation for Royalties & Right to Cut Script
- o Sound Log (including page #, start and end of cue, length, description)
- o UIL Letter of Script approval (if not on the Approved List)

*The entry fee is separate from the Region Academic Meet entry fees. The entry fee is \$TBA (waiting on clarification from UIL office and Region Academic site) and will be made out to Atascocita High School Theatre Arts (the Contest Site). Please call if further clarification is needed. Payment must be made to AHS the day of the contest.

Site Information:

UNIT SET: The basic unit set will be available to all schools. A right-hung door [1], left-hung door [1], window [1], and French door [1] unit will be available at the site.

SOUND: The AHS Tech Booth has a Soundcraft Series Two Sound Board with the ability to play: one CD and two Cassette Tapes. MP3 players provided by the competing schools can be plugged into the system using the "earphone" jack. Due to the unusual lay-out of the sound system (the CD player is at floor level), schools are encouraged to bring their own sound equipment.

LIGHTS: The AHS Tech Booth is equipped with an ETC Express 48/96 board. The board will be set as a Two Scene Preset. Schools may record light cues at their official rehearsal, but may not record submasters. See the attached light plot for more light information.

STAGE DIMENSIONS: The stage dimensions and distances between curtains are listed on the attached light plot. Only the black Back Drape will be used for this contest (no cyc). The house dimensions follow the light plot. The AHS Performing Arts Center seats 713 people.

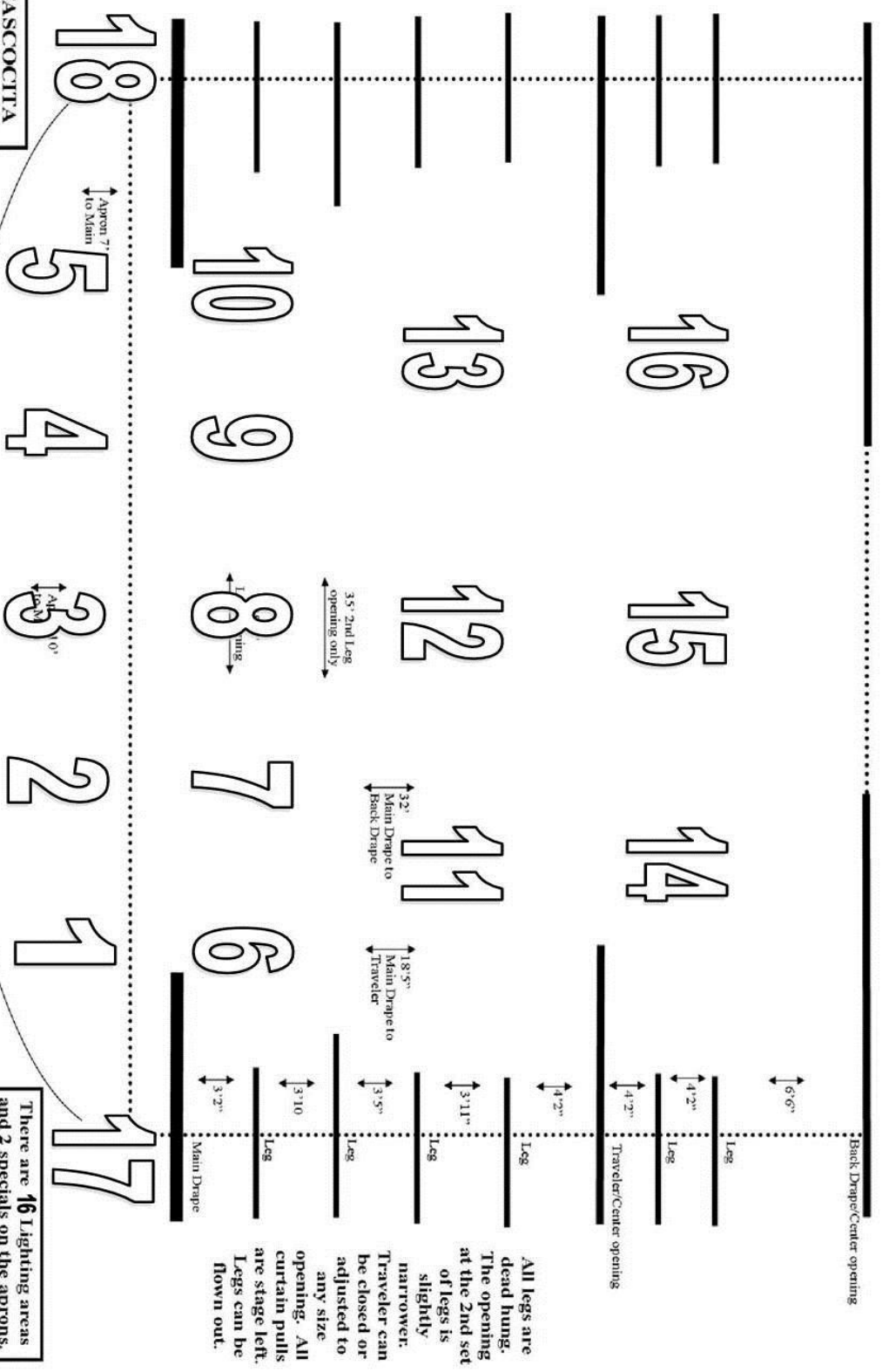
UNLOAD: Schools should unload at the AHS Theatre Scene Shop located in the back of the school. If you enter on Will Clayton Pkwy, drive all the way around the school to the dock area. If you enter from West Lake Houston Pkwy, the loading dock is in the middle of that parking lot.

AUDIENCE: Tickets are \$10 and are good for all six performances. Audience members should enter through the AHS Performing Arts Center/Gymnasium entrance. If entering from Will Clayton Pkwy, take a right past the main entrance and drive ½ way around the school. Signs will clearly indicate this entrance. Audience members will NOT be allowed to enter through the loading dock/fine arts wing entrance at the back of the school (nearest West Lake Houston Pkwy).

FOG/CYC/Etc.: Since Fog and a Cyclorama are now allowed at the State Contest, we will be allowing them at the Region Contest as well. However, the *heavy* use of talcum or other powders that stick to the stage floor, unit set, or drapes will not be allowed. If there are any questions about these or other elements, please ask prior to your official rehearsal, and make sure to show the contest manager during your scenic disclosure period (last 5 minutes of official rehearsal).

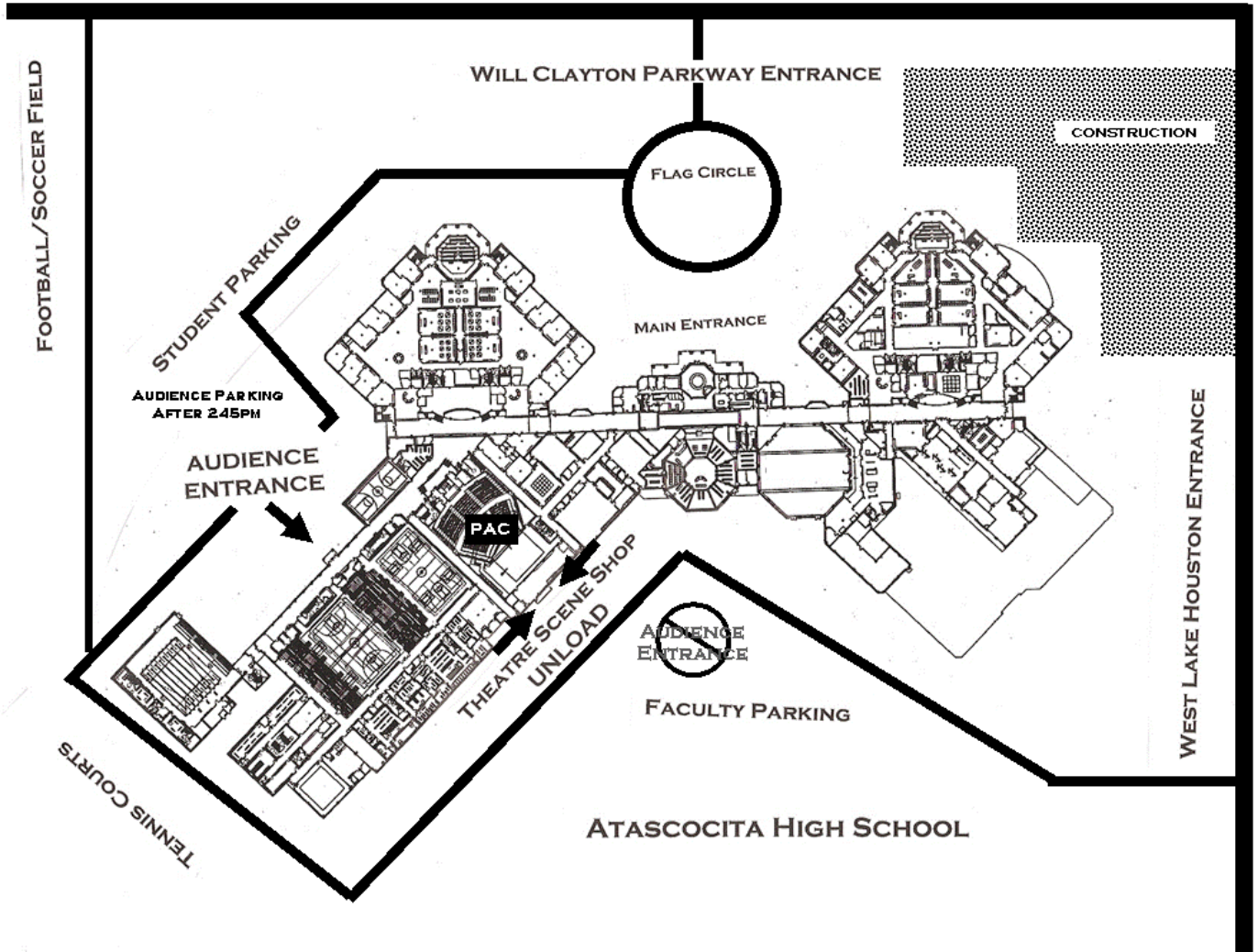
