Rules

1. You may submit one entry per category. It must be your work.
2. The entry does not need to have been published in a newspaper or publication, but it must have been created (written or photographed between April 1, 2016 and April 1, 2017).
3. You must email your entry to jacton@uiltexas.org by April 1, 2017.
4. We will announce winners (first through third place and honorable mention as needed) at the ILPC Spring Convention. You do not have to be present to win.

Categories

1. **General Objective Writing** - a feature or news story that relies on an interview(s) to drive the story.
2. **General Column Writing** - can be a personal experience or simply unique commentary on an incident, event, etc.
3. **General Feature Photo** - any type of feature photo is acceptable.

Sounds simple, right? *It is.*

Our goal is not to make hundreds of rules to complicate this contest. You have enough in your life that is complicated. We want you to write and to photograph. We want you to enjoy what you teach by experiencing it again.
