2	SECTION 1.	The United States will stop funding the military section of the Merida
3		Initiative in order to turn its attention to the troubling social issues in
4		Latin America.
5	SECTION 2.	The Merida Initiative will direct its funding towards solving issues such as
6		human rights, rural developmental aid, public health, poverty, and
7		disaster assistance.
8	SECTION 3.	The U.S. Department of State of Western Hemisphere Affairs will be
9		responsible for the implementation of this bill.

BE IT ENACTED BY THIS UIL CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 10 **SECTION 4.** This bill will go into effect on January 01, 2015.
- SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Resolution to Reduce the Minimum Drinking Age to 18

5		now, therefore, be it
6	RESOLVED,	That the UIL Congress here assembled make a recommendation to
7		reduce the minimum drinking age to 18.

A Bill to End the Cuban Embargo

- BE IT ENACTED BY THIS UIL CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 4 **SECTION 2**. The Cuban Embargo, a restriction on international trade between the
- 5 United States and Cuba since February 7th 1962.
- 6 **SECTION 3.** The State Department will declare an end to the United States embargo
- against Cuba, allowing trade to resume.
- 8 **SECTION 4.** This shall take effect July 1st, 2016.
- 9 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Secure the Border to Mexico

- 4 **SECTION 2**. To make a formal plan on how to deal with the minors immigrating into the United States.

- A. They will follow the new orders put in place by this bill.
- 8 **SECTION 4.** This new bill will be put in place on January 4th, 2015.
- 9 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

10		up for twenty years' worth of sewage problems in the region.

10		the United States people.

10	RESOLVED,	That the Student Congress here assembled stop all aid directed towards funding
11		Syrian rebel groups with arms or humanitarian assistance.

A Bill to Expand the Selective Service System

1	BE IT ENACTED BY THIS UIL CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:	
2	SECTION 1.	All American citizens shall register in the Selective Service System
3		upon turning 18 years old, regardless of gender.
4	SECTION 2.	The Department of Defense will be responsible for overseeing
5		implementation of this bill.
6	SECTION 3.	Implementation of this bill will be effective six months from the date
7		of enactment.
8	SECTION 4.	This bill shall not affect females who turned 18 prior to the
9		implementation date.
10	SECTION 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
11		void.

A Bill to Institute Federal Oversight in Assisted Living Facilities

1	BE IT ENACTED BY THIS UIL CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:	
2	SECTION 1.	The United States Federal Government shall institute federal
3		oversight for all state licensed assisted living facilities.
4	SECTION 2.	Assisted living facilities include Type I – Assisted Living Facilities,
5		Type II – Assisted Living Facilities and Small Health Care Facilities.
6	SECTION 3.	A congressional panel will determine the federal guidelines of
7		oversight. The Department of Health and Human Services will enforce
8		the desired course of action.
9	SECTION 4.	The law shall take effect January 1, 2015.
10	SECTION 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
11		void.

A Resolution to Increase Funding to NASA to Increase Innovation

WHEREAS, Increased privatization of space still requires the leadership and innovation of NASA; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the UIL Congress here assembled that NASA's budget for the 2015 fiscal year be increased to 5% of the total national budget.

- 2 **SECTION 1**. All US ports of entry will be equipped with the medical technology to test
- persons coming into the US for the Ebola Virus.
- 4 **SECTION 2**. Ports of entry: The access point for all citizens, immigrants, and tourists in
- 5 the US.
- 6 **SECTION 3.** A. The US department of health will provide the ports of entry with the
- medical equipment to test for the Ebola virus, and provide individuals
- 8 responsible for testing for the virus.
- B. The US border patrol will be responsible for securing individuals found
- positive of the Ebola virus, and sending them to proper medical facility.
- 11 **SECTION 4.** This bill will go into effect on Dec. 1, 2015.
- SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
