

#### **UIL LIGHTING INSTRUCTIONS**



The UIL lighting in the McCullough Theatre consists of nine (9) areas, (each approx. 12' in diameter) illuminated by two front lights and a down light. Red, green, and blue full-stage color washes are also provided. Two follow spots are provided, but their use should be specially requested.

Each group is required to limit their production to twenty (20) lighting looks. Blackouts and repeated looks are possible without diminishing the limit of twenty.

Please complete and return the attached lighting cue sheet and questionnaire by the deadline state elsewhere in this packet in order to facilitate your lighting needs.
