Scratches / Adds:

- DUE MONDAY, APRIL 15, 2024 at 5:00PM
- Any scratch/adds after Monday will not be included in the Regional Media guide.
- Coaches who scratch an athlete are responsible for notifying the next place qualifying athlete's coach of the scratch. Both coaches should submit a scratch/add form.
- Scratch/Adds made by coaches prior to the Monday, April 25th 5:00 pm deadline can be entered into Direct Athletics before closing. A Scratch/Add form must still be submitted.

UIL regional qualifiers who were scratched and relinquished their spot to an alternate are **not eligible to be reinstated**. Scratches or changes, for any reason, cannot be reversed.

Exception: Relays qualify as a school. Therefore, relay substitutions shall be allowed.

PlainsCapital Park Track:

- Coaches will not be allowed on the track or infield during competition.
 - EXCEPTIONS:
 - Coaches may assist with HJ marks until 1st call for field events.
 - Coaches may assist with relay marks from the end of the morning session until 1st call for running events in the afternoon session.
- Coaches may not review pictures of finishes. The Meet Referee must be contacted to resolve discrepancies or photo finishes.
- Protests must be filed in writing within 15 min. of announcement of event.

Uniforms:

- UIL uniform rules will apply amended from the National High School Federation Rules of the current year.
- Boys must wear shorts.

Athletic Tape:

- Must be used to spot take off markings for relays and all markings for high jump, triple jump, long jump, and pole vault!
- Other markings (i.e. half tennis balls, chalk, etc.) are prohibited!

Team Camp Tents:

 Qualifying teams set up camps in the EAST stands; NO camps or tents in the West side stands.

No Locker Rooms Available:

• Dress and shower facilities will not be available.

Trainers: Certified trainers will be available on site.



Running Event Notes:

- Starting blocks will be provided at the track or athletes may bring their own.
- The 200 Meter Dash will be run on the turn.
- The 800-meter runs are run on Saturday as finals.
- The 800m Run will start from an alley start.
- The 3200-meter runs will be run Friday morning at 10:30am.
- The 1600-meter runs will be run as finals after the 200-meter dashes on Saturday.
- The 'no false start rule' is in effect. Runners shall be disqualified on their first false start.
- Races with 2 heats will have the 1st place in each heat plus the next 6 best times qualifying for the finals.

Field Event Notes:

- Field event contestants shall assemble 1 hour prior to their event at the staging area by the south football goal post.
- Girl's triple jump will be a 28'/32' board; boy's triple jump will be a 36'/40' board.
- DISCUS and SHOT VENUE: Both 4A & 5A discus and shot shall be weighed between 7:30 and 8:30 am, at the Southwest Garage.
- The rings for Shot and Discus are concrete and require rubber sole shoes.
- A 34.92-degree sector will be used for shot and discus competition.
- Discus Throw Venue is located on the northeast side of PlainsCapital Park.
- Shot Throw Venue is located on the southwest corner of PlainsCapital Park by gate #3

• Pole Vaulters:

- Weigh in and poles inspections shall begin 1 hour and 45 minutes prior to their scheduled vaulting event at the trainer's station.
- Only Manufacturer's Pole Rating Marks are acceptable. The manufacturer's pole rating is to be included on the pole in a contrasting color, a minimum size of 3/4 inch, on or above the top hand-hold band.
- The failure to have the manufacturer's 3/4-inch contrasting color weight rating band on or above the top handhold position renders the pole illegal for use in competition.
- Etchings, serial numbers, etc., although containing pole characteristics for the manufacturer, shall not replace the pole rating manufacturer's mark. Homemade marks placed on poles are not acceptable...this includes pre-1995 poles.
- Emphasis... a pole altered "in any fashion" shall render the pole illegal for use in competition; this applies most specifically to poles that have been cut.

DRAW MEETING

- The 2024 order of seeding brackets shall be Boys Doubles, Boys Singles, Girls Doubles, Girls Singles, and Mixed Doubles.
- There shall be no proxy voting. Only a school representative with a player(s) in a bracket may vote.
- For seeding purposes, at the Coach's Meeting each coach may present information on their regional player.
 - Note...for information to be presented for seeding, that player's school representative/coach must be in attendance to present and discuss the information... i.e. Fall & spring tournament record...
 - Individual and Dual Matches
 - Win / Loss Record
 - Past History in District, Regional and State Competition
 - Other Relevant Information
 - (no proxy presentations or voting)

Substitutions:

- In doubles or mixed doubles, substitutions are allowed for one of the doubles or mixed doubles players in case of injury, illness, loss of academic eligibility or if a student is penalized by the school for misconduct or violation of the code of conduct.
- A school may not substitute for a singles player or a doubles team or mixed doubles team.
- The alternate single, doubles or mixed doubles must be used.
- After the tournament has begun, substitutions are not permitted.

Plan of Play:

- The scoring system shall be Advantage-Scoring, best 2-out-of-3 set matches with a 12-point tiebreaker at six games all in each set.
- 15-minute default rule in effect for a player not present when assigned to play.
- The point penalty system shall be used during matches.
- Foot faults shall be called.

Tiebreaker Procedures:

- A player (team) who first wins seven points shall win the game and the set provided he/she leads by a margin of two points.
- If the score reaches six points all, the game shall be extended until this margin has been achieved.
- Numerical scoring shall be used throughout the tiebreaker.
- The player (team) whose turn it is to serve shall be the server for the first point, which is delivered from the right court.
- His/her opponent shall be the server for the second and third points (delivered from the left court, then the right court), and thereafter each player (team) shall serve alternately for two consecutive points (left court, then right court) until the winner of the game and set has been decided.
- Players (teams) shall change ends after every six points and at the conclusion of the tiebreaker.
- Note that after any change of ends the server will be serving his/her second serving point.
