22. Currently in Conference 3A football, Schools are placed in districts based on geography and play the regular season. Division I and Division II playoff determinations are made after district representatives have been decided. Each district advances three teams to the playoffs. Of the three advancing teams, the school with the largest enrollment in grades 9-12 advances to the Division I bracket and the other two teams advance to the Division II bracket. Each Division of Conference 3A football plays for a state championship and two champions are crowned. Beginning with the 2012 season, the schools participating in Conference 3A football would be split approximately in half, with the largest enrollment schools comprising Division I and the remaining schools comprising Division II. Conference 3A football would consist of thirty-two (32) districts, with approximately six schools in each district. Division I schools would be placed into approximately 16 districts with other Division I schools. Division II schools would be placed into approximately 16 districts with other Division II schools. Three teams would advance to the playoffs from each Division I district and three teams would advance to the playoffs from each Division II district. Each Division of Conference 3A football would play for a state championship and two champions would be crowned. Do you favor a rule change that splits the Conference 3A football alignment into divisions prior to the season as is currently done in Conference 1A Six-man , 1A 11-man and 2A football?
