Please note the following items.

- **7:15 AM**- Contestants and coaches will be permitted to set up computers.
- **NOTE: NO EARLY ADMITTANCE.** Do not enter the room until instructed to do so. Do not block the hallways or doorways with your equipment so others using the building can easily get by.
- **8:15 AM** Contest begins.
- **7:45 AM**-The Coaches' Meeting will be held in **San Jac Multipurpose Room (SJH 207)**. All coaches and contestants are encouraged to attend.
- **9:15 AM**- Grading will start promptly in UTC 3.132. **All coaches are required for grading or student will be disqualified.** Please bring a calculator and pen. Coaches unable to grade are asked to provide an alternate and advise Linda Tarrant, state computer applications director, as soon as possible at linda@hexco.com.
- No computers, repair services, copy stands or holders are provided at the State Meet. If you find there is a problem on your system at the competition, another student or coach may be willing to lend you a replacement, but it is best to bring your own backup equipment.
- Coaches and contestants should not interact between the contest and grading periods, so please make sure that your students know where to go at the conclusion of the contest and where to take their equipment.
- Keep the area outside the room completely quiet as a courtesy to all the contestants.
- Verification and Awards are scheduled for **1:30 PM at Bass Lecture Hall**.
