

Affirmative Negative

Affirmative has impacts that "total" 100 points.

CP solves 100% of case and gets 100 points.


DA links to 1AC action (-50 points)


DA doesn't link to CP (+/-0 points)

The best counterplans...



Solve all or most of the 1AC offense.

Easier to outweigh.

Use a DA that links to the 1AC, but not the CP.
Easier to outweigh.

Find one flaw of the 1AC.

Prima facie burden.

Proves the better policy option.

Easy as 1-2-3!

Counterplan Types*



Agent CP

Changes simply who does the plan.



Process CP

Changes a procedural order/sequence with the plan.



Advantage CP

Tries to solve their advantages a totally different way.

Articulates a reason why CP+1AC together. the CP is bad.

Create a deficit for why the 1AC solves better. quicker, more efficiently.

Solvency

Theory Theoretical reasons to reject the negative team.



Affirmative's can preempt the CP by adding evidence to their 1AC which answers or justifies certain parts of the resolution.
