Former South San Antonio ISD Supt. Abelardo Saavedra was paid more than \$138,000 after leaving the District, according to a resignation and separation agreement with the board obtained from a source who wished to remain anonymous.

Under the agreement, Savedra was owed \$50,575 in salary he would have earned had he stayed at South San through August 11, plus \$88,237 dollars for his 82 unused days of leave. His contract was to expire at the end of the physical year and he gave up \$49,499 in pay he was entitled to in an effort to exit the district amicably, the agreement knot available online said.

Trustees voted unanimously to approve successor Flores' contract earlier this month.

"The one that's responsible, ultimately, for that, is of course the superintendent," Prado said. "Why do we pay him money to leave when he's left our district in bad standing"?






