*See the Contest Rules. <u>Each conference</u> advancing from an ESC Region to State shall submit a bill or resolution to be considered for legislation in their conference chamber. ESC officials may **not** submit legislation borrowed from another region. Legislation may come from the region docket or be new original legislation written by the state-qualifying students. It is recommended regions submit an alternate piece of legislation, should there be duplicates from other regions or other issues.

Region Clerk has their choice for Parliamentarian who will serve on behalf of the ESC at State Meet submit the Parliamentarian form.
