

Registering for UIL State 2021 on SpeechWire

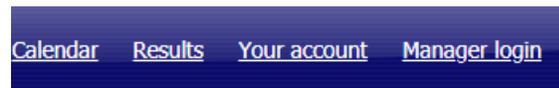
Registration for the UIL state tournament will take place on SpeechWire. To log in to your school record, go here:

www.speechwire.com/login

If you already have an account, you can skip the next section.

Need to create a SpeechWire school account?

In order to register for the UIL State Speech and LD tournament on SpeechWire, you will need a SpeechWire school account. If you do not already have one, you can create one by going to www.SpeechWire.com and clicking “Your account” in the upper right corner of the page:



After clicking “Your account”, click Create account, and follow the steps that follow to create your school account. There is a step that asks you to enter your school name – that page provides a list of schools in Texas that already exist in the system. *Please check the list and see if there’s already a school record for your school so that you don’t create a duplicate.* If there’s already a school record for your school and you don’t have access to it, please email accounts@speechwire.com for assistance in gaining access to it.

If there isn’t a record already for your school, you can create one using the page that follows. It will ask for your name and email address. The email address is where your initial account password will be sent, so be sure to use one you have access to. Your email address will also be what you use to log in to register for the state tournament.

Managing/Creating your students’ SpeechWire accounts

Because the tournament is running using NSDA Campus as its video platform, all students participating must have SpeechWire accounts set up that they can log into to access the buttons that will take them to their video rounds. *This is due to the design of NSDA Campus, which was designed with this level of security to ensure that buttons only appear to students who are scheduled to be in those video rounds.*

To create or manage student accounts, click the “Team roster” button on your coach account home page:

Once you have clicked that, you will be able to add students to your roster. Make sure to include their email address; they will immediately be emailed a link to click to activate their student account once you add them if you included an email address. You can click on a

student to edit their record and add/change an email address if needed. Also, if they are having trouble activating their account, there is a button to manually set their password after you click their name. In that way, you can set their password to something you make up, then share that with them so they can log in. *Manually setting their password immediately activates their account, so you can register them into the state tournament at that point.*

Accessing registration

Once you have an account and have logged in, click “Tournament registration”:

After clicking Tournament registration, click “View open tournaments”. You will see the SpeechWire calendar – look under May 2021 and find “UIL Speech and LD State Meet 2021”. Click the Register link on the row for the tournament:

*Remember – because the tournament is holding video rounds on NSDA Campus, every student taking part ***must*** have an activated SpeechWire student account! They do NOT need an NSDA account, just a SpeechWire account! If you need to create your student accounts, refer to the “Managing/Creating your students’ SpeechWire accounts” earlier in this document.*

Once you have added all of your entries and selected their names, click the “Update entries” button. You can leave the “Division” set as Varsity. This is what a team with four entries might look like:

Registering your judges

For UIL Speech State, only schools who qualified students in LD Debate are required to provide judges. See your contest rules.

First off, you do **NOT** need to ask your judges to create their own SpeechWire judge accounts. **Judges should NOT create their own accounts on SpeechWire!** As you register them, if they don't already have an account, one will automatically be created for them and they will be emailed login details to use to judge the tournament.

To register your judges, click "Update your judges" on the tournament registration home page:

Once you do, click "Add a judge to your entry":

To add a judge, click the 'Add a judge to your entry' button.

Type in the judge's email address and click "Search for judge":

If the judge already has a SpeechWire judge (or coach) account, their name will automatically be filled into the field that appears. You can correct it if needed – either way, you then will click "Add this judge to your entry. *Coaches can use their SpeechWire coach login email and password to judge the tournament at <https://live.speechwire.com>.*

If they do not already have a SpeechWire judge (or coach) account, you will need to type in their name and click "Add this judge to your entry", which will email them a password they can use to judge the tournament and will add them to your entry:
