**TECHNICAL SPECS**

Congratulations and welcome to the Austin ISD Performing Arts Center. The Performing Arts Center is a state-of-the-art facility designed specifically to enhance the arts experience for all students, staff and community members nationwide. The triumphant centerpiece of the Performing Arts Center is our 1,200 seat Main Hall with incredible acoustics and audio-visual systems. We look forward to having you in our space and seeing the magic of each of your shows!

The Main Hall has a proscenium stage with an apron and a covered orchestra pit. The proscenium opening is 60' wide and the stage is 50' deep. The performance space for this competition will be **40' wide** and **39'5" deep** from curtain line to US Traveler.

All legs are dead hung and will be set to have a **40' opening**. The grand curtain is on a track and can be set to various openings depending on your show.

## **LIQUID, BREAKABLES, ATMOSPHERICS**

The AISD PAC has a very sensitive fire suppression system that can be triggered by any particle. We ask that any liquid, breakable scenic / prop elements along with any atmospherics (*haze, fog, powder etc.*) must be approved by the Austin ISD PAC Coordinator or Production Supervisor prior to arrival. No Glitter, Confetti, Helium Balloons, or Pyrotechnics are allowed in the building.

## **LIGHTING**

Located Back Center of House

Ion XE 20 Light Board running software version 3.1.5

Please see attached 2023 OAP Channel Light Plot for specific channels:

Apron Areas 1-5 have 5 ETC D40 Vivid LED Par top light. Apron has face light (Areas 1-5)

Separate warm (R02) and cool (R60) face light is provided.

Areas 6-20 have LED top light from 15 ETC D40 Vivid LED Par top light.

Separate warm (R02) and cool (R60) face light is provided.

Cyc lights are 17 LED Philips Selecon fixtures hung on the 4th electric.

There are black Edison plugs located at the front and the back of the stage on SL and SR if needed for any type of extra lighting brought in by schools.

*All legs are tabbed in for a **proscenium of 40'** which cuts off specific lighting areas. If you close the grand you will lose areas 6,10. If the grand is open you only lose access to areas 11,15,16 and 20.*

## PRE PROGRAMMED LIGHT CUES

UIL State Lighting Designer will pre program your light cues based on a submitted lighting cue sheet. The Cue sheet is located \_\_\_\_\_. Please make sure to fill out a cue sheet, and follow saving instructions, by **end-of-day on March 8th.**

## DRESSING ROOMS / HOLDING ROOMS

2 Dressing rooms (1 Large and 1 Small) are located upstage right with an adjoining large common area for hair and make-up.

Each school will have a dressing area assigned for their use during the contest located near restrooms. Please always keep/leave the dressing room clean and neat. Schools are strongly encouraged to eat meals in their designated holding space, full company tables are not provided. The school's director(s) will be held accountable for any food or drinks found in the dressing rooms during the competition day.

## LOAD-IN

Loading dock (2'h x 38'w) garage door (12' x 12") is located directly behind the stage.

Groups can load directly onstage through the matching garage door that is located upstage right.

UIL Set will be stored upstage of the cyclorama. All elements of the UIL Approved Basic Unit Set will be available.

Sets storage will be decided by the Contest Manager, generally 3-4 areas stage left and or 3-4 areas in Scene Shop or outside Dressing Rooms area.

Parking is located in an adjoining AISD parking garage located in PAC ground plan. Special arrangements will be made for parking for buses, trucks, and trailers at a later date.

*By Travis County Fire Code permanent set pieces may not be placed in the fire curtain line which is designated by 2 dark green lines of spike tape that run full length across the stage.*

## PATRONS

Parking is available in the AISD parking garage free of charge. Patrons may use largest set of 4 doors (North Entrance) closest to the parking garage/Mueller Blvd. to enter the main lobby.

We ask that all patrons only enter through the Main Hall doors located on either side of the lobby and do not wander backstage down the side hallways. Balcony seating availability will be determined by PAC staff and Contest Manager before performances begin.

Food and drink is only allowed in the tiled main lobby, however neither are permitted in the Main Hall at any time.
