Documentation & Entry Fees: Please bring all required documentation (license to perform, proof of royalty payment, UIL approvals, community standards form, and integrity script) plus

any correspondence with the UIL State Office to your technical rehearsal. Please also bring the entry fee of \$750.

Dressing Rooms: Each school will be assigned their own dressing room for the entirety of the day. Please bring your own mirrors and power supplies as many of the rooms don't have many outlets. Also, please remember these rooms are classrooms and need to be returned to the state they were found.

Lighting: ETC Ion light board. We utilize a 20 area light plot. We also have LED color washes with mixing capabilities, and LED cyc lights with mixing capabilities. We do NOT have a follow spot. Please see the simplified light plot below.

Sound: Yamaha CL-3 soundboard. It is fitted with an aux cable to plug in laptops, tablets, or phones. You are welcome to use our system or bring your own.

Stage Dimensions & Curtains: Stage Width= 50'; Stage edge to back curtain= 50'; Stage edge to Mid-stage= 35' 4"; Apron Depth (edge of stage to main curtain)= 15' 3"

We have a traveling Grand Drape, a mid-stage traveler and a traveling blackout (back) curtain. All can be open or closed as far as you'd like to reduce the stage width if necessary. There is also a white cyc curtain in the very back as well that you are welcome to use.

Communication: We have headset communication for both the sound and light technicians in the control booth and headsets both backstage right and left.

Unit Set: We have a complete unit set. Including Standard Doors & Windows, & French Doors

Stage Weights: We have several stage weights and sand bags that you are free to use, or you can bring your own.

Load-In/Load-Out: You will load in from the loading dock on the back side of the PAC. You will load into our shop and move set pieces onto the stage for your technical rehearsal. Props and set pieces will be stored in another shop area closer to the stage. After your performance you will strike to the shop you loaded into and proceed to load out.
