We do ask that you strike out to the loading dock as you finish your performance.

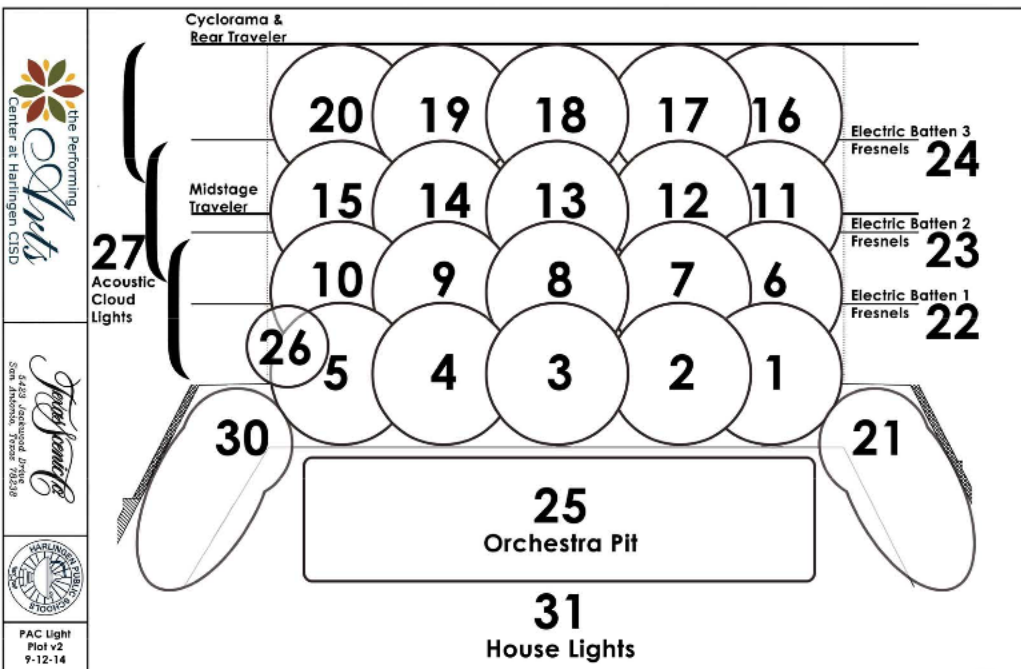
