ENTRIES: Entries will be determined by the results of the District Championship. 4 qualifiers will advance in each event. The District Meet Director will email the results and the "Advancers File" immediately after the conclusion of the District Championship. A swimmer may swim in a maximum of four events, no more than two of these events may be individual events.

All competitors, once officially entered, shall compete in all heats, swim-offs, and rounds of competition for which they qualify, except when an illness or injury forces a competitor to withdraw. This applies to individual members of relay teams, not entire teams, as well as competitors in individual events. Failure to compete for any reason other than illness or injury shall disqualify the competitor from any further competition in the meet. Previous performances are not nullified. A competitor may be reinstated by the meet referee in a later event after illness/injury if a certified physician or referee verifies recuperation.

TIMERS: Each school will be responsible for providing **1 adult** timer for each day (Prelims & Finals). Timers will be provided a session pass for their family to enter the pool free of charge.

PRELIMS: There will be 3 heats in Prelims. 4 / 6 / 6 (Pyramid Seeding)

FINALS: In Finals there will be 2 heats of 8 (Consolation & Championship)

DIVING: Each diver will submit their dive sheet immediately following the District Championship. Diving entries shall be submitted on <http://www.cleanentries.com> Changes may be made up until one hour prior to the start of the diving competition. Diving competition will be run electronically. Each diver shall perform eleven dives, five voluntary and six optional. Please refer to the National Federation rule book for the order of dives (Rule Book, p. 62, Sec. 4, Art. 1).

ENTRY FORMS: **At the conclusion of the District Meet, the Meet Director will send an "ADVANCERS" report and copy of FINALS RESULTS** to the Regional Director by midnight after the District Meet. This file is located through: "File", "Export", "Advancers", "Select All", type in "4" as the number of qualifiers from each event to advance. Then select "Export", save it to a file and email it to the Region Meet Director.

RELAY ONLY SWIMMERS: You must provide a list of your "**Relay Only**" swimmers. These are swimmers who have not qualified in individual events but **will / may** be used on your relays.

SCORING: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11 ~ Championship Finals individual events and double for relays.
9 - 7 - 6 - 5 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1 ~ Consolation Finals for individual events and double for relays.

AWARDS: Team trophies will be awarded to the Region Champion in both the girls and boys divisions. Medals will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers in each event. Ribbons will be awarded to the 4th through 8th place finishers in each event. Certificates will be awarded to the Outstanding Male and Female Diver and Swimmers. This is a **TISCA** award and will be determined through Hy-Tek Meet Manager Program. Only **TISCA** members may vote for, or be nominated for Region **Coach Of The Year**.

STATE QUALIFIERS: The top two (2) finishers of each swimming event and the top four (4) finishers in diving will automatically advance to the State Championship in San Antonio, February 9 & 10, 2023. The remaining 8 qualifiers in each of the swimming events shall come from the top 8 times throughout the state.

WARM-UP / COOL DOWN: The diving well may be used for warming up and cooling down during the meet. *However, the lane nearest the starting blocks shall remain closed.* Also, please inform your athletes to be aware that there is a foot ledge 5' beneath the surface on each of the turning walls as well as at the starting end of the competition pool.

THURSDAY EVENING WARM-UP: The pool will be available for any teams coming in Thursday evening between 5:00 pm and 7:00 pm. ***If the DIVING event is still taking place, please have your teams wait in the hallway until it has concluded.*** There should be minimal distractions for the divers.

LOCKER ROOMS: All girls will use the 2 locker rooms available in the pool area. The boy's locker room is located downstairs.

COACHES AND OFFICIALS MEETING: 11:45 am Friday and 10:45 am Saturday

ADMISSION: Adults ~ \$ 5.00 Students ~ \$ 3.00

We ask that **all** spectators sit in the designated area for spectators, which are in the permanent bleachers and the 3 sets of portable bleachers nearest the middle of the pool opposite the permanent bleachers. **No lawn/folding chairs on will be allowed on the pool deck.** There are 2 areas for handicapped spectators on the deck. The pool deck area should be clear for the teams, coaches, officials and workers. Also, there is a handicap accessible elevator. If you need assistance please contact Coach Waldmann.

MUSTANG NATATORIUM REGULATIONS:

Buses shall park in the “Home” parking lot of the Football stadium (West of the football stadium).

Spectators shall park in the “Home” parking lot of the Football stadium or on the street in the marked spaces in front of the Baseball Field.

To enter the pool, please use the ramp nearest the Tennis Courts.

The acoustics are less than excellent and the noise can be deafening. Announcements concerning events and heats will be made. However, each swimmer is solely responsible for making their event on time.

One way traffic permitted on the bulkhead from Lane 1 towards Lane 8.

No folding or lawn chairs on the deck. Spectators are asked to sit in the permanent bleachers.

UIL prohibits all types of artificial noisemakers within the facility.

Signs and banners may not be taped or attached to the walls within the facility.

Glass items are prohibited within the facility.

Smoking is prohibited within the facility.

Pets are not allowed in the facility.

Headsets must be used with all radios, CD players and MP3 players.

UIL rules prohibit any shaving within the facility.

Please be aware of the foot ledge at either end of the diving well, as well as the starting end of the competition pool. The foot ledge is at a depth of 5 feet.

DIRECTIONS TO THE POOL

Directions to Andrews

From Odessa:

Hwy 385 North. Turn Left at the first stop light coming into Andrews. Follow Mustang Drive around to the football stadium. Turn right on the street past the parking lot in front of the Baseball Field. The football stadium will be towards your right and the Performance Center will be in front of you. To get to the pool go up the long ramp on the left side of the building nearest the Tennis Courts. The Natatorium will be down the hall.

From Big Spring:

Hwy 176 West. Turn Right at the first stop light coming into Andrews. Follow Mustang Drive around to the football stadium. Turn left on the street past the Baseball Field before you get to the parking lot for the football stadium. The football stadium will be towards your right and the Performance Center will be in front of you. To get to the pool go up the long ramp on the left side of the building nearest the Tennis Courts. The Natatorium will be down the hall.

From Seminole:

Hwy 385 South. Turn Right at the first stop light coming into Andrews. Follow Mustang Drive around to the football stadium. Turn left on the street past the Baseball Field before you get to the parking lot for the football stadium. The football stadium will be towards your right and the Performance Center will be in front of you. To get to the pool go up the long ramp on the left side of the building nearest the Tennis Courts. The Natatorium will be down the hall.

From Kermit & Eunice:

Hwy 176 East or Hwy 115 East. Turn Left onto Mustang Drive. Follow Mustang Drive around to the football stadium. Turn right on the street past the parking lot in front of the Baseball Field. The football stadium will be towards your right and the Performance Center will be in front of you. To get to the pool go up the long ramp on the left side of the building nearest the Tennis Courts. The Natatorium will be down the hall.
