AUSTIN, June 5 -- South San Antonio broke loose for five runs in the sixth here Wednesday night to win its fourth Class AAA state baseball title, 8-1 over Fort Worth Castleberry.

Bill Maricl, who pitched the first two innings and the last three for the Bobcats, picked up the win, while Joe Robertson, who went all the way for Castleberry, was the loser.

Meddie Lomas hit a bases-filled triple to spark the Bobcats to their big rally in the sixth. He had four RBI all told. Lomas, Larry Black and George Magro each had two of South San's seven hits.

Castleberry scored an unearned run in the fifth.

South San, which never has lost a state tournament game, had previously won state championships in 1950, 1959 and 1961.

Robertson, who had won in relief Tuesday for Castleberry, walked 11 South San batters.
