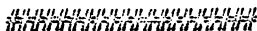

AUSTIN, June 4 -- Lufkin nipped San Antonio Lee, 1-0, on a sixth-inning run as the Class AAAA division of the annual boys' baseball state tournament opened here Tuesday night.

Two pitchers with almost the same last name -- Joe Lowe of Lufkin and Larry Rowe of Lee -- tangled in a brilliant duel of three-hitters.

Lufkin pushed across the only run in the sixth on a walk by Left Fielder Roy Ilyers, a sacrifice bunt and a double to deep right field by Center Fielder David Brevell.

Losing pitcher Rowe struck out 11 batters and walked Ilyers twice. Lowe, a left-hander, struck out only four but issued only one walk.

The win advances Lufkin to the AAAA finals, with the Panthers meeting either Lubbock Monterey or defending champion Houston Bellairre in the finals Wednesday at 9 p.m.

Lee managed seven baserunners all told, two of whom were cut down at second on fine defensive plays. Lufkin in all had six runners on.

Lufkin is making its fifth state tourney trip, but has never won the title. The Panthers reached the finals in 1958 but lost 6-4 to Austin. Lee was making it to the tourney for the second time--but the first in AAAA. Last year the Volunteers were in Class AAA.
