A U S T I N, Texas (Spl) --- West Texas continued its domination of the 1951 Girls State High School Basketball Tournament here Saturday morning as the McLean Tigerettes advanced to the finals of the Conference A division by defeating Plano's Wildcats, 44-31.

McLean established its superiority early Saturday, moving to a commanding 14-4 lead in the first quarter. Leader in the early firing was Bonita Bailey, but scoring honors went to Dorothy Gudgel, queenpin of the Tigerettes' attack. She scored 25 points, her biggest spree coming in the third quarter when she counted 10 points.

Barbara Davidson led the losers with 16 points.

McLean's defense was led by Guard Joyce Bruner, who did a good job on rebounds as well as defending.
