

CHAMPIONSHIP CONFERENCE A-GIRLS

AUSTIN, Mar. 12--For the second straight year Margaret Odom and the Dimmit Bobbies proved too much for the Granbury Eagles as the Bobbies waltzed to a 62-44 victory over north Texas girls and pick up their second straight conference A State Girls basketball tournament championship.

Last year the same two teams battled in the finals of the state meet with the Bobbies grabbing a 56-60 victory.

Odom, who holds the individual scoring title for conference A, paced the champs with 28 points--giving her a total of 46 points in the tourney as compared to the 48 she tallied in one game last year. Ann Speer ran second to Odom with 19 point.

Leading the Granbury attack was Shirley Rains who hit 25 points. Her sister, Lela Mae Rains, was second with 10.

The game was nip and tuck for the first half with Dimmit holding a 17-11 lead at the end of the first quarter and a 29-25 lead at halftime. ~~Granbury~~ Six points was the biggest lead of the first half.

Dimmit ~~quickly~~ got started fast in the second ~~quarter~~ half and had a 10 point lead built before Granbury could get rolling. From then on Granbury never got closer than six points. Dimmit led 47-39 at the end of the third quarter and got an 18 point lead ~~at the end of the game~~ at one point in the final stanza.
