A high-scoring sister act helped the Granbury Pirates win their way into the finals of Conference A of the State girls basketball tournament here Friday night, as Granbury trimmed George West, 64-51.

Shirley Rains, Granbury forward, tallied 37 points to set a new conference scoring record, while Leta Mae, her sister, added 14 more.

George West had two potent point-makers in Jane Williams, with 24, and Pat Troell, with 23.

The victory put Granbury into the finals in the State tourney for the second straight year. Last year they lost the Conference A-AA title to Dimmitt, 66-50. The return of Dimmitt made possible a second meeting of the two teams. Dimmitt first must defeat Goldthwaite to gain the finals again, however.
