Bovina 90, Skidmore-Tynan 80

A U S T I N, March 14---Bovina broke two scoring records and defeated Skidmore-Tynan, 90-80, here Saturday morning to advance to the Conference B championship game of the ninth annual Interscholastic League girls' basketball tournament.

Bovina's 90 points broke the existing single-game team high-scoring records in Conference B and for the entire tournament, bettering the old mark of 86 set by North Hopkins (Sulphur Springs) last year.

The two teams' 170 total broke B and tournament aggregate records. The old mark for both teams was 158, set by Collinsville and North Hopkins in 1956.

Janice Richards scored 43 and Joan Ezell added 32 points to lead Bovina. Elizabeth Gold and Judy Wallek each scored 27 points for Skidmore-Tynan.

Bovina had three 20-point-plus quarters, falling shy of that mark only in the fourth. The Fillies took a 24-16 lead after eight minutes and were ahead 46-37 and 74-60 at the next intermissions.

The victory advances Bovina into the Conference B championship game, with the Fillies playing defending champion North Hopkins of Sulphur Springs for the crown Saturday at 9 p.m.

Skidmore-Tynan will play Hawley for third place at 6:15 p.m.

North Hopkins defeated Hawley, 71-47, in an earlier game Saturday.
