Roosevelt High School of Lubbock completed an unbeaten season Saturday afternoon fending off a determined Jourdanton rally to win the Class A state girls basketball championship 77-71.

The win was the 40th of the season for Roosevelt, which shot a torid 75 percent from the field, hitting 24 of 32 shots.

Led by deadly shooting Alice Woolley and Dee Gregory, Roosevelt jumped to a 31-17 first quarter lead and never trailed although Jourdanton pulled to within five points, 74-69 with 30 seconds left to play.

Miss Woolley drilled in 29 28 points the first half, hitting 13 of 17 field goal attempts including the first nine she attempted, to get Roosevelt off and running. Roosevelt led by as much as 20 points, 41-21 in the second quarter before Carolyn Dornak, Joe Nell Collier and Sue Myers sparked a belated Jourdanton comeback.

Dornak took high honors with 43 points while Woolley had 38 and Gregory 31.
