#### **MEET INFORMATION**

#### NEW FOR 2024 – State Qualifiers' Webinar: February 6th @ 7:30pm. Join the Webinar Here.

The purpose of this meeting is to review procedures and process for the State Meet. UIL Staff and Meet Administrators will be presenting the information and available to answer questions.

**State Qualifiers/Scratches:** Regional final times will be used for seeding heats for the State Meet. All state qualifiers will be named on the UIL Website.

- **Swimmers:** The first and second place winner in each of the four (4) regional swimming meets will advance to the State Meet. The next eight (8) swimmers with the best regional final times overall will advance to the State Meet.
- **Divers:** The top four male and top four female divers, regardless of degree of difficulty, will advance from each regional competition to the State Meet.
- <u>Scratch Form</u>
- Girls Relay Confirmation Form Please declare your girl relay members along with alternates.
- Boys Relay Confirmation Form Please declare your boy relay members along with alternates.

**NOTE:** If your school qualified a relay, you MUST submit a Relay Confirmation Form no later than February 9<sup>th</sup>. Changes will be allowed to relay members at the State Meet if needed. The number of alternates allowed at state depends on the number of relays you qualify. (1 relay = 2 alternates; 2 relays = 3 alternates; 3 relays = 4 alternates) \*Due to limited deck space, please submit only the names of athletes for relays and relay alternates who may actually be needed to swim.

**Divers:** The rules in the National Federation Swimming and Diving Rules and Records Book shall be followed regarding dive list format for entries.

Diving entries must be submitted through <u>www.cleanentries.com</u> starting January 29<sup>th</sup> through Monday, February 5<sup>th</sup>, no later than 11:59pm CST. Questions regarding entries should be emailed to: Brittany Thomas, <u>bthoma15@neisd.net</u>. Changes can be made online after registration closes until 6:00pm on Wednesday, February 14<sup>th</sup>.

**Buddy Passes**: Teams who are required to bring a buddy if they have one male or one female qualifier will need to request a comp ticket at packet pick-up. Comp tickets will not be given out after your packet has been picked up.

Administrator Comp Tickets: Each qualifying school will be given two comp tickets (good for both sessions), comp tickets will need to be claimed by the athletic director or administrator at the front desk of Josh Davis.

**Packet Pick-up:** Schools may pick up packets on Wednesday, February 14<sup>th</sup> between 2:00 and 4:00pm at Josh Davis Natatorium ticket office. Schools and athletes will not be allowed inside Josh Davis on Wednesday. Packets are also available starting at 8:00am on Friday, February 15<sup>th</sup> at the Josh Davis Natatorium front desk at entrance.

**School Parking:** School bus parking will be in the lot behind Josh Davis Natatorium. School suburbans and other vehicles can also park in the football/tennis parking (see map).

State Venue Location: Josh Davis Natatorium (12002 Jones Maltsberger Rd. San Antonio, TX 78216)

**Ticket Sales:** *All tickets will be sold online only*. Please communicate this to your parents and administration. Online tickets will be available starting February 5<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am. Please communicate to parents that the facility has a clear bag policy and outside food and drink will not be allowed. <u>Purchase tickets here.</u>

#### Deck Access:

**Participating Athletes-** All swimmers and divers must have a tattoo to be admitted into the pool deck area. Each school will be provided one tattoo per participant. **PLEASE NOTE**: schools with one qualifier will be provided one complimentary ticket, good for general seating, in the event that a non-participating athlete is travelling with your participant.

\*\*\*Lap Counters- If you have a single state qualifier who is participating in the 500 Freestyle, we will provide your school with one additional tattoo.

**Swim & Dive Coaches-** Each school will be provided ONE wristband inside of their school packet. Additional wristbands may be requested as long as the school has the appropriate number of qualifiers based on the chart below.

## NO additional wristbands outside the aforementioned parameters will be given. A comp ticket can be asked for at packet pick-up for any additional *swim or dive* coaches when a school does not qualify for an additional wristband.

\*\* If a school has a swimmer(s) and diver(s) qualify for the State meet, coaches will receive an additional wristband for the dive coach. A school only qualifying divers (and not meeting thresholds above) will receive only one wristband.

Athletic Trainers: Will not be granted access to the pool deck. EMT and athletic training staff will be provided on site.

**Videographer (Diving):** Schools are allowed to appoint one individual (per diver) to videotape diving for the purpose of All-American Diving qualifications. *The individual who is listed as the videographer will be required to show a photo ID in order to obtain credentials to the diving well. Videographer credentials can be picked up Wednesday during packet pick-up or Thursday upon arrival.* The Dive Film Pass MUST BE sent to the UIL prior to the State Meet (instructions on the form itself).

**Coaches'** Area: During swimming competition, the area behind the white chains is reserved for school coaches only. We ask that this area is designated for coaches with participants in the event taking place. Team members will be prohibited in this area.

**Team Seating:** A team seating assignment diagram will be available in the school packet. Coaches are responsible to see that only school coaches and participants are in their assigned area. Teams assigned seating behind the diving boards may be asked to relocate for the duration of the diving competition.

**Locker Rooms:** Participants are responsible for securing their own valuables. Locks must be removed after each session. Shaving onsite will be grounds for disqualification.

**Officials:** Meet referees will be selected by the UIL Staff. The meet referees will assist UIL Staff with the selection of the State Meet officials.

Meet Committee: A meet committee shall be appointed by the UIL for the State Meet.

**Rules:** National Federation Rules will be followed. Decisions of the referee are final. Protests in writing must be submitted to the Meet Director.

**Scoring:** 16 places will be scored in all individual, relay, and diving events. Points shall be scored by the following: <u>Individuals</u>, 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11 for final; 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 for consolation; <u>Relays</u>, scored double.

**Results:** Results will be posted in the hallway outside the locker rooms and upstairs for spectators. Live results will be available on the UIL Website (<u>http://www.uiltexas.org/swimming-diving/state/swimming-diving-state-meet-qualifiers-results</u>).

Heat Sheets will be provided to coaches on Thursday and Friday upon their arrival.

#### Awards:

- All participants finishing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> must report according to the awards schedule to the awards area.
  - If your athlete(s) finishes 1<sup>st</sup> in an event, we ask that you report to the awards' stand with your athlete and help the UIL in draping all medalists.
- Swimmers and Divers of the Meet will also be announced and presented with a plaque.
- Championship, runner-up, and third place team trophies will be presented after the last event.
- UIL will allow additional medals to be purchased onsite for teams finishing first, second or third.

Programs: Swim & Dive programs will be digital this year. You can access the digital version of the program here.

**Photos:** MaxPreps, the UIL sanctioned photographer, will be taking photos & photos at the awards stand. These photos can be purchased <u>here</u>.

**Food and Beverage:** One cooler per team is permitted with food and drinks. Glassware is strictly prohibited. Concessions will be available.


