

## Cross Country Regional Sites

Update

Region I – Mae Simmons Park – Lubbock, Texas – No restrictions on the course.

Region II – 1A – Sherrod Park – Abilene, Texas – No restrictions on the course.

### **Region II – 2A-6A and Region III 1A – Lynn Creek Park – Grand Prairie, Texas**

- Due to the fact that 11 inches of rain has fallen at Lynn Creek Park, access to the course on Sunday will be extremely limited. In order to have the best possible conditions for the races on Monday, the course will require time to dry out. Teams may still come out to Lynn Creek Park on Sunday from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. for packet pick-up. New course maps will be handed out at this time. If desired, warm-ups on paved areas will also be allowed.
- Coaches and athletes should be prepared for muddy, sloppy, conditions on race day. Decisions regarding warm-ups will be made as we continue to monitor course conditions.
- Parking on Monday will now be free of charge.

### **Region III – 2A-6A – Kate Barr Ross Memorial Park – Huntsville, Texas**

- The course has received substantial amounts of rain. Monday is going to be wet, sloppy, and muddy. All access to the course on Sunday will be restricted; and no one will be allowed on the course.
- Teams are allowed to come out to the course, but are to stay off the flagged/painted areas that make-up the course. The course is very well marked and painted, therefore athletes should have no problem following the course come race day on Monday.
- All warm-ups will be moved off the course. There are several areas that can hold the athletes for warming up prior to racing. The Northeast corner of the upper field will be open to warm-up as well as the two areas on the Northwest corner of the park.

### **Region IV – 1A-6A – Texas A&M Corpus Christi Track and Stadium Ground – Corpus Christi, Texas**

- No restrictions on the course. Races will continue through rain, as long as no lightning occurs.
