

UIL 1A State Marching Band Contest Pilot Information

- The UIL 1A State Marching Band Contest Pilot will be held in the Alamodome in San Antonio on either Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday, November 6, 7, or 8, 2017.
- All 1A bands that earn a Division I rating at their Region Marching Band Contest will be eligible to enter. There will be no Area Contest.
- Whether or not a 1A school plays 6-Man or 11-Man football is irrelevant to eligibility for the pilot contest.
- If a 1A school has “opted up” to 2A for athletic purposes that school may still participate in 1A music – C&CR Section 1102(a)(3).
- Bands that wish to advance to the state contest pilot will complete the “intent to advance” form with their region executive secretary prior to the region contest.
- As with all conferences the UIL State Office will communicate entry procedures and contest information to eligible schools upon advancement. All details will be posted as they become available at <http://www.uiltexas.org/music/marching-band/state>.
