<u>Proposed Amendment to the</u> <u>University Interscholastic League Constitution and Contest Rules</u>

A. Brief Explanation of Proposed Amendment

This proposal amends section 1204(m), *Fee Schedule*, Constitution and Contest Rules by providing an increase in fees paid to sports officials.

B. Factual and Policy Justifications

The proposed amendment provides an alternative to a proposed fee schedule increase presented by TASO to UIL staff. This amendment would increase the fee schedule in Section 1204 by \$5.00 across the board. (See amended fee schedule set out below.) If approved, this would be the first increase to the official's fee schedule since 2009.

D. Potential Fiscal Impact of the Proposed Rule to Member Schools

The \$5 addition to each of the fees in Section 1204 will result in an increase that ranges from 2% to 25% depending on the contest, with an average increase of roughly 9% added to the official's fee schedule. UIL member schools would see a comparable increase in the amount of fees paid to sports officials.

E. Legislative Council Consideration; Effective Date

If approved by the Legislative Council and the Commissioner of Education, this amendment shall be effective August 1, 2015.
