The following Written Proposals Submitted by the Public will be considered by the appropriate standing committee, but will not be presented at the public forum.

1. A proposal to assign charter schools, within the boundaries of a school district, to the same conference as the high school with the highest enrollment
2. A proposal to change the age eligibility date to August 1
3. Proposals to ban Native American themed mascots
4. A proposal to reschedule soccer to fall and volleyball to spring
5. A proposal to add 1A districts for baseball
